The Boston Preservation Alliance is soliciting nominations for its Annual Awards program. The 2010 awards recognize exemplary preservation projects or activities that have been completed within 2009. Submissions are limited to properties and programs in Boston's neighborhoods and downtown area in the categories listed below.

Winners of this year's Achievement Awards will be honored at the Alliance's 2010 Awards celebration to be held in October. **Nominations must be received by Friday, April 16, 2010.**

Categories considered by the Awards Committee:

1. Notable new construction in harmony with Boston's built environment.
2. Significant renovation/restoration preserving Boston's architectural or cultural heritage.
3. Significant public art contributing to Boston's urban fabric.
4. Notable examples of parks, landscapes, and natural areas that are new or have been preserved or restored.
5. Significant lighting and design in the harmony with Boston's built environment.
6. Significant neighborhood preservation efforts.
7. John Codman Award for lifetime achievement in preservation.

* Please try to choose a category for the project even if a project fits into multiple categories or it is unclear which category is most appropriate. The Awards Committee will contact you if they feel that the project is better suited to a category other than the one you identify.

- Site plan and floor plans, if applicable.
- Key members of the project team with contact names, companies, addresses, telephone and email addresses must be included with the submission.

The Alliance presents awards to owners in categories **1** thru **5**. Project team members are also recognized as appropriate and to the greatest extent possible.
